

## Galston Circular

## East Ayrshire Walks



Enjoy this walk behind the village of Galston. Starting at Barr Castle, the route takes you along quiet country roads before returning to the start along the River Irvine. A hilly walk - worth it for the views!

**Distance: 2.6 miles**

- 1** From Barr Castle head along Barr Street and left onto Cemetery Road. Follow Burn Anne as it flows beside this quiet lane, emerging at B7037 Cessnock Road.
- 2** Take care crossing over onto Clockston Road and continue uphill on this country road for half a mile.
- 3** At the top of the hill turn left to start heading back downhill, eventually reaching Maxwood Road. Take time to admire the views down into the village and across to the Isle of Arran!

**4** At the bottom of Maxwood Road, look out for a track on the right - rougher ground heading through a line of trees. Follow this as it descends towards the river.

**5** Turn left at the farmhouse to follow the River Irvine to the Galston running track. Cross over the length of the running track onto Barrmill Road.

**6** At the end of Barrmill Road turn left. Continue straight ahead through two crossroads on Wallace Street leading to Barr Street and back to Barr Castle.
